Let's Talk about Grad Assemblies

We have already met with our grade 12 students to discuss the schedule for the graduation ceremony and dry grad celebration, to share information on grad fees, to promote our first grad event (Halloween movie night) and grad clothing opportunities, to share information about our Transcript Verifications/Graduation Checks process in November, to remind them that now is the time for post-secondary admissions, and to let them know grad photos take place in December.

Graduation Events, Ceremony and Fees

SAS staff look after the Graduation Ceremony and various Graduation Events throughout the year. We host an <u>outdoor</u> Graduation Ceremony here at SAS, under large tents, overlooking beautiful Shuswap Lake. Graduates will be given an alphabetically determined scheduled time for their ceremony, between 10am and 4pm.

- The SAS Graduation Ceremony is on Wednesday, June 24.
- The Graduation Fees of \$175 (due May 1) is applied to the following expenses: the Graduation Ceremony, Grad Events, Grad Photo Sitting Fee, Yearbook, Grad Gown Rentals, Keepsake Cap & Tassel, Lanyard, and Composite Folder with the Grad Class Group Photo
- Grad Fees do not go toward the Dry-Grad Celebration. The Dry-Grad Celebration is 100% fundraised.

SAS Dry Grad Celebration

Grad parents/guardians work with our Grad Teacher Sponsor and School Administration to plan, organize and run the Dry Grad Celebration. Rhys Waters, our Vice Principal, is the lead contact for Dry Grad.

- The SAS Dry Grad Celebration also takes place on **Wednesday**, **June 24 (6:30pm 12am)**.
- We will advertise and host a parent meeting early this winter to solicit volunteers to help with our Dry Grad celebration.
